- For a great trip to Cuba where our workers and Deaf are expanding the ministry to new locations, into the mountains and now on The Island of Pines off the coast of Western Cuba.
- For the two new schools for the Deaf that opened in Uganda in January. The enrollment is increasing daily!
- For God's protection of our workers and the Deaf community in the North East of Mexico. Every day is a challenge with the violence that permeates the border areas.

Pray:

- For Mexico. Pray for continued protection and wisdom as the leadership in the ministry makes necessary changes to make the ministry more effective and economical to operate.
- For Cuba. Pray for the mattresses needed for the training center. Classes start in February and sixteen mattresses are needed for the Deaf to sleep on while at the training center.
- For the Bahamas. Pray for the details regarding the 2019 summer camps and for the folks God would have to be part of these teams.
