TRIANGLE

One of the earliest symbolic representations of the Holy Trinity was an equilateral upward-pointing triangle. The three equal sides with equal angles represent the three persons in one God.





TRIQUETRA (TRINITY KNOT)

An ancient Celtic symbol, the Triquetra was adopted by early Christians to represent the equality of the Father, the Son, and the Holy Spirit.

FLEUR DE LIS

The three sections of the Fleur-de-Lis represents the Holy Trinity. But it's also believed to represent the tears of the Virgin Mary at Jesus' crucifixion.







SHAMROCK

As legend has it, the shamrock's three leaves made it an ideal visual aid for St. Patrick to teach the pagans about the Holy Trinity.

BORROMEAN RINGS

These three interlocked circles represent the idea of the unity of the Trinity and the worship of one God. Traditionally, the word 'unitas' was written in the center, and the syllables 'tri-ni-tas' were distributed in the outer sectors.






SHIELD OF THE TRINITY

The classic Shield of Trinity symbol dates back to the 12th century. It's a Christian visual symbol that explains the doctrine of the Trinity.
